Tendering Package - Accommodations

As presented by Meet PEI

The Concept

Prince Edward Island has been selected to host a portion of the filming of a TV series that will be filmed across Prince Edward Island. Beginning prep early June, with filming continuing into September 2026. As such, there is a requirement for accommodations to host the cast and crew, as early as the first week of June 2026.

Filming the show on PEI will provide great exposure to the Island, many Island locations will serve as the backdrop in many of the scenes. Hosting of the cast and crew will also stimulate the tourism sector and leave a lasting economic spin off.

Cast and crew will have staggered arrivals and departures depending on their role(s) within the production.

Meet PEI

In this instance, Meet PEI is assisting with the administration of a “tender / procurement” process to determine both the availability and interest for the provision of accommodation.

Cast and Crew Size

It is anticipated that the cast and crew size will range from 80-120 individuals that accommodations will be required for at any given time.

The Schedule (TBC)

The TV series will be filmed over a three-month period, with accommodations required from June to September 2026.

Criteria for Accommodations

To be eligible as an accommodation provider, the following criteria must be satisfied:

- This tendering process is open to all PEI licensed accommodation providers including but not limited to hotels, motels, cottages, B&Bs etc. Only licensed accommodations will be accepted.
- It is anticipated that multiple accommodation establishments will be required to meet the demands. As a result, there is no minimum number of rooms/units that one establishment must have to be considered.
- Each property may host multiple members of the cast and/or crew.
- There are three identified groups/timeframes that must be hosted. Please see requirements below.
- Please identify what laundry services are available at your establishment. In-suite laundry is required for specific groups. Please reference the requirements below.
- Please identify any requirements as it relates to the length of stay required.
- Please identify cancellation policy.
- All guests **must** have access to Wi-Fi.
- Please outline housekeeping services as it relates to your establishment.
- In your submission, please identify which hosting requirement, see list below, that you are bidding on.
- Ideal situation is that guests would not be required to change accommodations, that they would remain in their unit for the duration of their stay.

Meals

There are no meal requirements; however, please provide any information as it relates to restaurants or food & beverage service available on site or nearby.

Staff and Operations

To ensure the health and safety of all staff and guests, required protocols as it relates to checking in, housekeeping services, staff screening etc. will be shared with each respective establishment at the time of booking. These protocols will be dictated by the Production Team.

Costs

All accommodations for cast and crew will be paid for by the Production Company. Deposits will be paid at time of booking. If advanced deposits are required, please note.

Selection

The Production Company will be responsible for tender selection.

Radius

The production will be based out of Charlottetown, maybe a master booking in Charlottetown but they will be travelling all over PEI and looking for availability from tip to tip to tip.

Detailed Accommodation Requirements:

Will consider, hotels, cottages, B&Bs, Inns, condos, VRBO and AirBnB across the Island

Requirement 1:

As of June 8th – up to 14 weeks (staggered)

Number of individual accommodation units needed: Three producers and 30-35 crew

Number of individuals per unit: One (would look at shared as long as separate bathroom for each) Must have: private bedroom, kitchenette & bath, Wi-Fi, laundry in unit

Budget: \$5000 per month / per unit (hotels please note can be nightly rate but looking at max \$5000 per month)

Notes: To be high-end units. Unit must be available for exclusive use for the time indicated.

Preferred no moving of units/rooms for this group.

Requirement 2:

As of June 22 – up to 12 weeks (possibly staggered)

Number of individual accommodation units needed: additional to #1 above x 30-35 crew

Number of individuals per unit: one (can be shared if there is a bathroom for each person)

Must have: private bedroom, kitchenette & bath, Wi-Fi, laundry in unit

Budget: \$5,000 per month / per unit

Notes: High end unit preferred. Unit must be available for exclusive use for the time indicated.

Preferred no moving of units/rooms for this group.

Requirement 3:

July 6 – 10 weeks

Number of individual accommodation units needed: additional to #1 and #2 above, 10 Cast plus 20-40 crew.

Number of individuals per unit: One

*Must haves: private bedroom, kitchenette & bath, Wi-Fi, laundry on site

Budget: \$5,000 per month / per unit

Notes: Can not be shared units. No moving of unit or room for this group

Notes

The Production Company understand that hosts may not be able to provide individual kitchenette for shared accommodations. Individual accommodations (hotel rooms, B&Bs, etc.) will also be considered that do not have in-suite kitchens.

Guests are to have exclusive use of their unit for the duration indicated in the above list of requirements. If required, a guest may be moved once over the course of their stay to another unit on the same property in order to accommodate a previous booking, unless otherwise indicated in the above list of requirements.

Parking is to be available for all accommodations. Please specify if parking is not available at your accommodation.
