

Drone Policy

Brookvale Provincial Ski Park

Out of safety concerns for guests, employees, and park property, as well as concerns for individual privacy, Brookvale Provincial Ski Park prohibits the operation or use of unmanned aerial systems, or drones, by the general public – including recreations users and hobbyists – without the prior written authorization from the Park. This prohibition includes drones used for filming or videotaping, as well as any drone use by media or journalists operation above or within Brookvale Provincial Ski Park boundaries.

This prohibition on drone operations or use extends to any drones launched or operated from Park property, as well as drones launched from private property outside of the Park boundaries. Please contact Brookvale Provincial Ski Park Supervisor, Allan Matters at 902-658-7863 if you have any questions or if you seek prior authorization to operate any aerial drones.

Any violation of this policy may involve suspension of your skiing or snowboarding privileges, or the revocation of your season pass, as well as confiscation of any drone equipment and may subject violators to any damages, including, but not limited to, damages for violations of privacy and/or physical or personal injuries or property damage, as well as regulatory fines and legal fees.

Unmanned aerial drone use by guests or the media is prohibited without prior written approval of Brookvale Provincial Ski Park.
